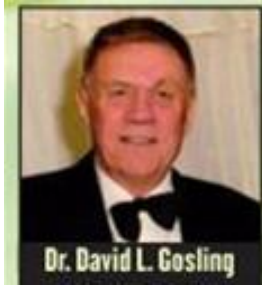


Rev. David Gosling, Assistant Chaplain 1984 - 89

Ministry

Soon after his ordination as a deacon, he was appointed Honorary curate, LANCASTER (St Mary) Blackburn (1973-1974)

Honorary curate, KINGSTON UPON HULL (St Matthew w St Barnabas) York (1974-1977)

Honorary curate, COTTINGHAM (St Mary) York (1978-1983)

He was appointed Asst Chaplain at Holy Trinity, Geneva, in the Diocese of Gibraltar in Europe 1984-1989. It may have been at this time that he was also the Director of Church and Society at the World Council of Churches.

He returned to England as Curate, CAMBRIDGE (St Mary the Great) w St Michael Ely (1989-1994) and was appointed Priest in charge, DRY DRAYTON (St Peter and St Paul) Ely (1990-1994)

He moved to India to work with USPG (United Society Partners in the Gospel) India (1995-1999), teaching at St. Stephen's College, University of Delhi.

He possibly returned to England, and had Permission to Officiate at Ely from 2001-2017

He is a Spalding Fellow of CAMBRIDGE Clare Hall College since 2001.

He moved back to Asia, as Principal of Prince Edwardes College, University of Peshawar Pakistan 2006-2011

He is an academic supervisor in the University of Cambridge.
